

The new MS Australia


- MS Australia and MS Research Australia merged in 2020
- Bringing together of activities
 - Research
 - Advocacy
 - Education and Awareness
 - Governance and Operations





MSA Strategic Planning

- Developing strategic plan for the new entity 2022-26
- Focus groups around the country
- Consultations with Member
 Organisations, international bodies
- Research & advocacy priorities survey
- Strategic plan to be launched later this year



Research and Advocacy Priorities Survey

- Repeat of 2016 survey to determine priorities of the MS community
 - Research
 - Advocacy
 - Strategy
- Undertaken July-August 2021



Research Priorities

- Asked about overall priorities
- Questions drilled down into specific research questions
- Very powerful, as we could split according to different respondent characteristics eg: connection to MS or type of MS
- Able to compare and contrast with the 2016 results

 Priorities align with the current research strategy and allows us to use the detailed data to plan for the future


 Commitment to supercharge the research agenda for MS in Australia

MSA Research Strategy – MRFF Proposal

- Find cures through repair and regeneration
- Develop better treatments and prevent MS via co and shared infrastructure
- Support and expand clinical trials for the cure and prevention of MS





MS Research in Australia

MSA proud to currently fund:

- 7 national platforms
- 4 international platforms
- 60 ongoing individual research grants

- Overall we have funded:
- Over \$47m in MS research
- 327 individual grants



- Applications invited
 - Annual grant rounds for most grant types
 - Incubator Grants two rounds per year
 - 2021 has the largest ever number of grant types: projects, scholarships, postdoctoral and senior fellowships, paired fellowships and incubators
 - Targeted call projects call for applications in a specific area
- International subject-matter experts approached to provide peer-reviews
- Applicants provide 'rebuttals' to reviewers comments
- Application materials sent to RMC members
- RMC meet in October each year review, discuss and rank applications
- RMC Chairs present recommendations to MS Australia CEO


